Level 1

- Act or mime a scene from a recent event you have attended
- Show five types of body language, for example feeling happy, sad, angry, fed up or confused
- Show that you can:
 - turn on and log into a computer
 - use a piece of software, for example email or a game
 - name the main parts of a computer system

Level 2

- Be able to spell your name and home town using the phonetic alphabet (A = Alpha, B = Bravo, C = Charlie and so on). Take a look at the https://h2g2.com/edited_entry/A8245910 to find out more about the phonetic alphabet
- Write or dictate a reading, poem or prayer then read it aloud
- Pass on a message clearly using a phone
- Send an email or letter to the head teacher saying what you would like to change about Goffs Oak Primary and Nursery School
- Show how to use a mobile phone, or Skype

Level 3

- Know how two-way radios (such as those used by the police, ships and aeroplanes) can be useful
- Learn the finger-spelling alphabet or other recognised non-verbal communication and be able to:
 - 'say' your name
 - ask someone their name and understand the reply.
- In a language other than your own:
 - say your name
 - order some food and drink
 - count to ten
 - say hello and goodbye.
- Make a display, an audio or video advert for Goffs Oak Primary & Nursery School
- Write your name using Grade 1 Braille
- Show that you can:
 - send or reply to someone with a short email and include an attachment
 - download photos or other media from a camera or smart card
