

Snow and Ice



In this activity we want you to have fun outdoors in the snow and ice having made sure that you are prepared for the cold weather by being suitably dressed!

Level 1 – Complete 4 of these:

- Follow a footprint trail in the snow/frost
- Make snow angels
- Use coloured water to draw pictures in the snow
- Build snow castles instead of sandcastles
- Catch a snowflake on your tongue
- Make a snowman and decorate it with natural objects

Level 2 – Complete 4 of these:

- Catch a snowflake on your tongue
- Sculpt animals in the snow, decorate them with natural materials
- Play Noughts and Crosses in the snow using sticks and stones
- Use cubes of coloured frozen water to lay a trail for others to follow
- Make a target and throw snowballs at it
- Watch and measure icicles as they form and melt
- Snow is difficult for the birds to find food so make a bird feeder and hang it in a suitable place
- Make a snowman, decorate it with natural objects. Write instructions for how to make it

Level 3 – Complete 5 of these:

- Have a snowball fight
- Find out about the right clothes to wear in the snow
- Try hula hooping in the snow, is it more difficult when you have lots of clothes on?
- Make faces on trees using snow
- Find out how to safely break the ice on a fish pond
- Paint some graffiti in the snow using coloured water spray
- Make an igloo
- Every snowflake is said to be different. Using magnifying glasses see how many different shapes you can find
- Write a poem about snow and ice
