

English

In English this term the children will be using a wide genre of books to write letters, chronological and non-chronological reports, speeches and instructions with the final big write as a narrative on bravery, an information leaflet and a poem.

Reminders

- Maths homework will be set weekly on Friday and English will be set fortnightly also on Friday's. Both homework's are due on Wednesday.
- PE will be on Monday and Wednesday. The children need to make sure they have their PE kit in school those days. The PE kit is black shorts, black tracksuit, yellow t-shirt and black sweatshirt or school sweatshirt.

MATHS

This term the children will be starting with place value where they will learning to recognise the value of each digit in two-digit numbers, numbers upto a hundred on a number line, reading and writing numbers in numerals and words. counting in 2,3,5 and 10's. They will then cover addition and subtraction of two two-digit numbers, number facts to 20 and adding and subtracting using a variety of methods. Lastly, in the final term, the children will be looking at shape (2D and 3D) and properties.

As part of the maths curriculum in Year 2 we encourage children to practice their 2,5 and 10 times tables regularly. They can practice this on TT Rockstars.

LEARNING MEANS THE WORLD

During the Autumn term in Year 2, we will be covering two exciting topics. The first Topic is 'Arctic Circle'. Pupils will learn about the location, weather and climate in the Arctic, as well as the wildlife that lives there. Inuit people, their traditions and customs, will also be studied. The second topic is 'Land Ahoy'. This unit focuses on Science and Geography. The Science element is based around sound, speed and motion and begins by exploring how things move, linking with a pirate's journey around the continents and ocean. Throughout these topics all foundation subjects will be covered and provide Year 2 with lots of wonderful learning opportunities.
